#### Consultation on Proposed Import Control on Polyacrylamide Gel (PAAG)

In view of recent cases involving the abuse of polyacrylamide gel (PAAG) for breast augmentation, the government proposes to impose import control on this substance in order to protect public health. I write to seek your views on this proposal.

The government envisages a public expectation for a speedy measure to protect public health while permitting of the legitimate uses of PAAG. It is being considered to amend the existing Import and Export (General) Regulations (CAP 60A) to include PAAG (polyacrylamide gel) as a product which requires a licence for its importation. Under this proposal, all importers of PAAG are required to apply for an import licence from this department. For import approval to be granted, the importer has to declare that the product is not intended for use inside human body.

A questionnaire has been prepared to give more details on this proposal and solicit your views on this matter. Briefing sessions on the proposal will also be held on 2.8.2006 and 4.8.2006 respectively. For import approval to be granted, the importer has to declare that the product is not intended for use inside human body.
