The new requirement on procurement of medical devices (MDs) by the Department of Health



Purpose

▶ To enhance the protection of public health

- To ensure the safety, quality and performance of the medical devices procured by DH and to ensure the availability of after-sale (post-market) support from suppliers
- To raise users' awareness of medical devices (MDs) listed under MDACS and to raise the public awareness of the importance of MD safety

Procurement Requirements

- All applicable MDs being procured by DH are preferably be listed under Medical Device Administrative Control System (MDACS) w.e.f 21 June 2023.
- Quotation: A preference will be given in the quotation for listed MDs under MDACS
 - If there are more than one lowest conforming offers offering the same price, preference will be given to the MDs offered which are listed under MDACS.
- Tender: A technical score will be given in the marking scheme for listed MDs under MDACS
 - In assessment criterion under the tender evaluation, marks will be given for MDs offered which are preferably be listed under the MDACS.
- If the proposed MD is accepted by the Government, the Tenderer shall be bound by such offer and shall be deemed to form part of the Contract.
- For details of the procurement requirements for a particular MD, please refer to the tender documents.

Submissions to be provided by Supplier for indicating the compliance of the desirable requirements

- To indicate in the schedule of tender/ quotation whether the Item(s) offered is listed under MDACS
- To provide HKMD listing number and a copy of valid Certificate of Listing under MDACS.

Apply your application now

- Traders are encouraged to submit applications for their MDs to be listed under MDACS as soon as possible.
- For application for listing of MDs, please refer to MDD website (<u>https://www.mdd.gov.hk/en/mdacs/listing-application/medical-device/index.html</u>)
- The vetting and approval of an application for listing a device should normally be completed within 12 weeks following the submission of the application and all the required supporting information, including labelling samples. (ref.: <u>Guidance Notes GN-01</u>)
